

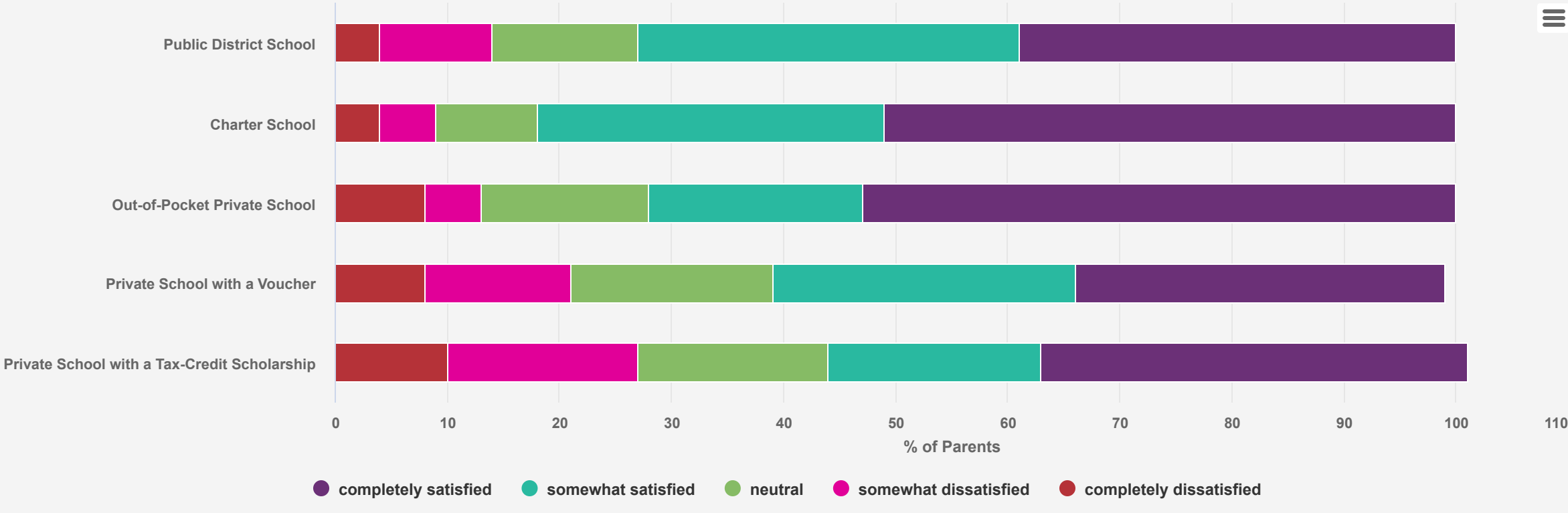

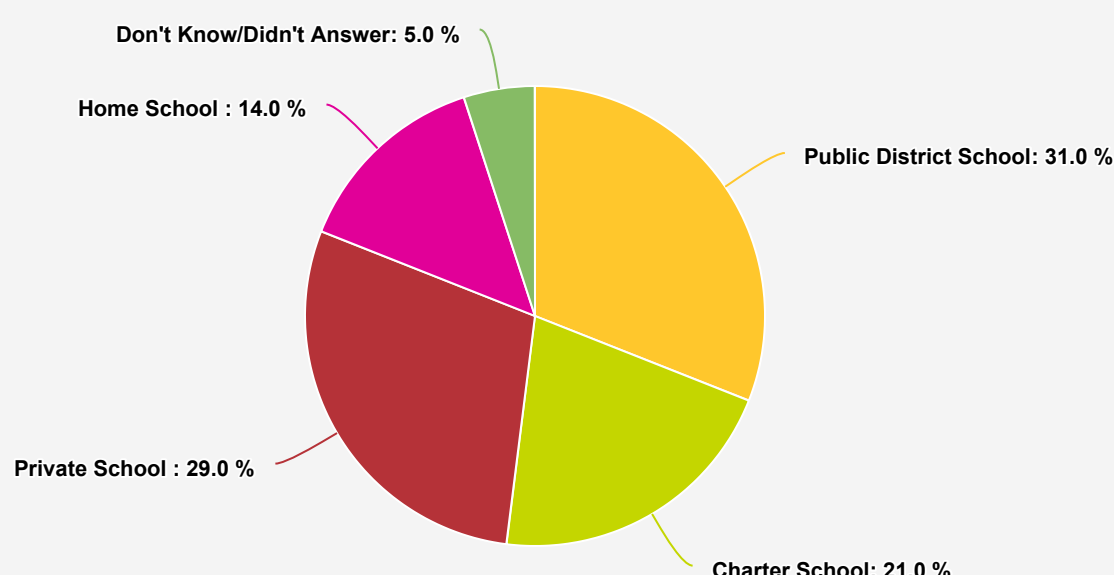

Arizona School Parents' Satisfaction with their Current Schools



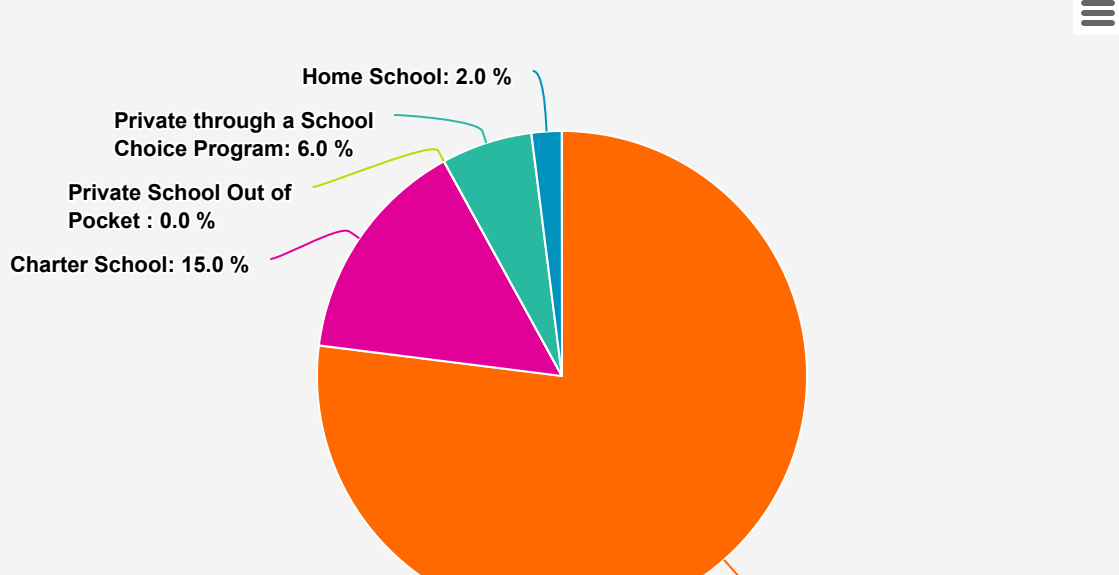

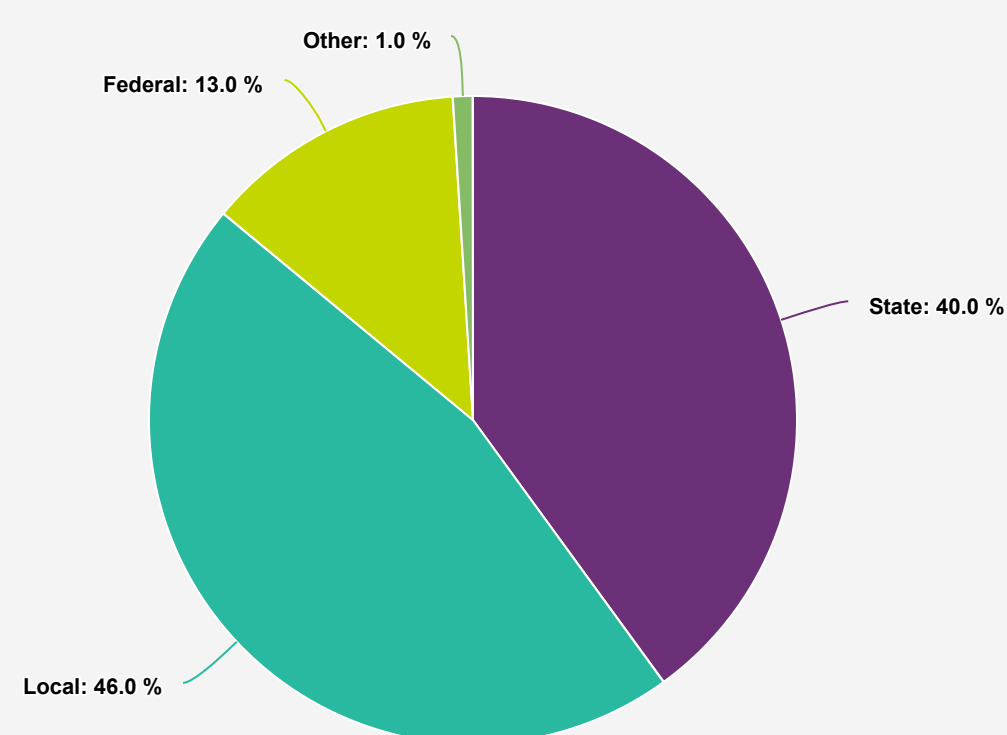

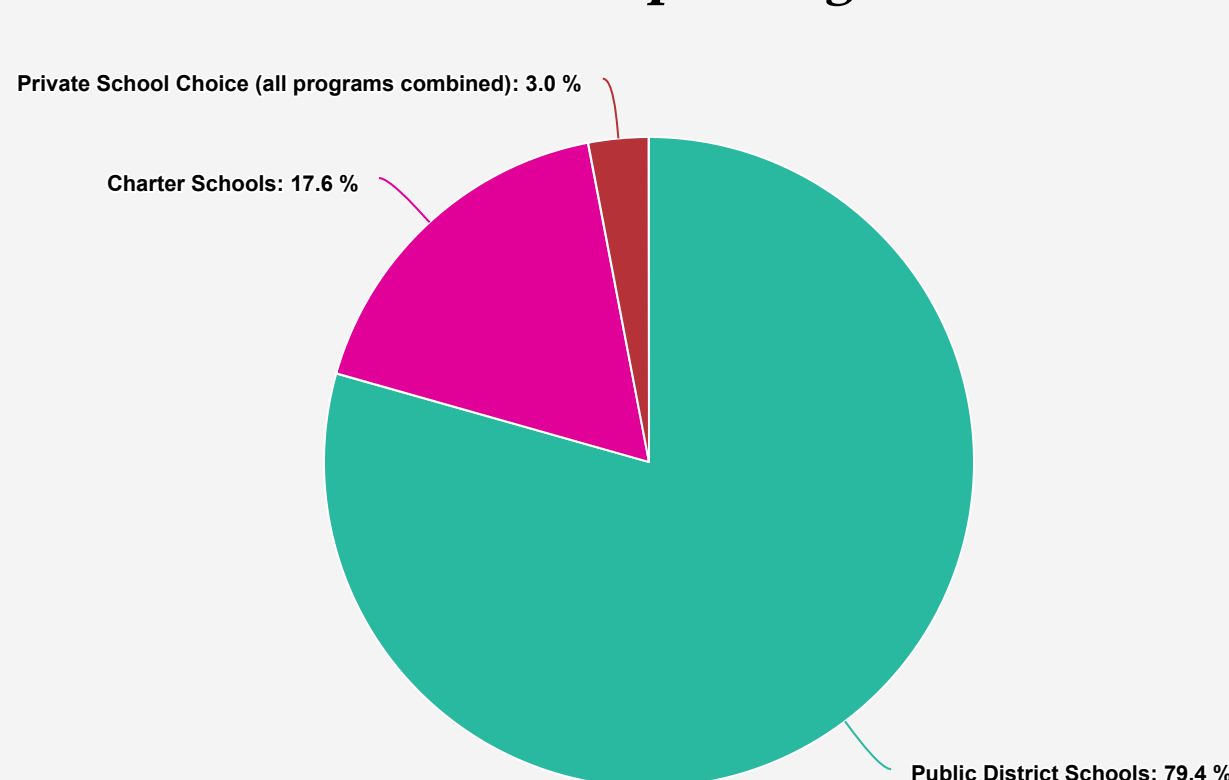

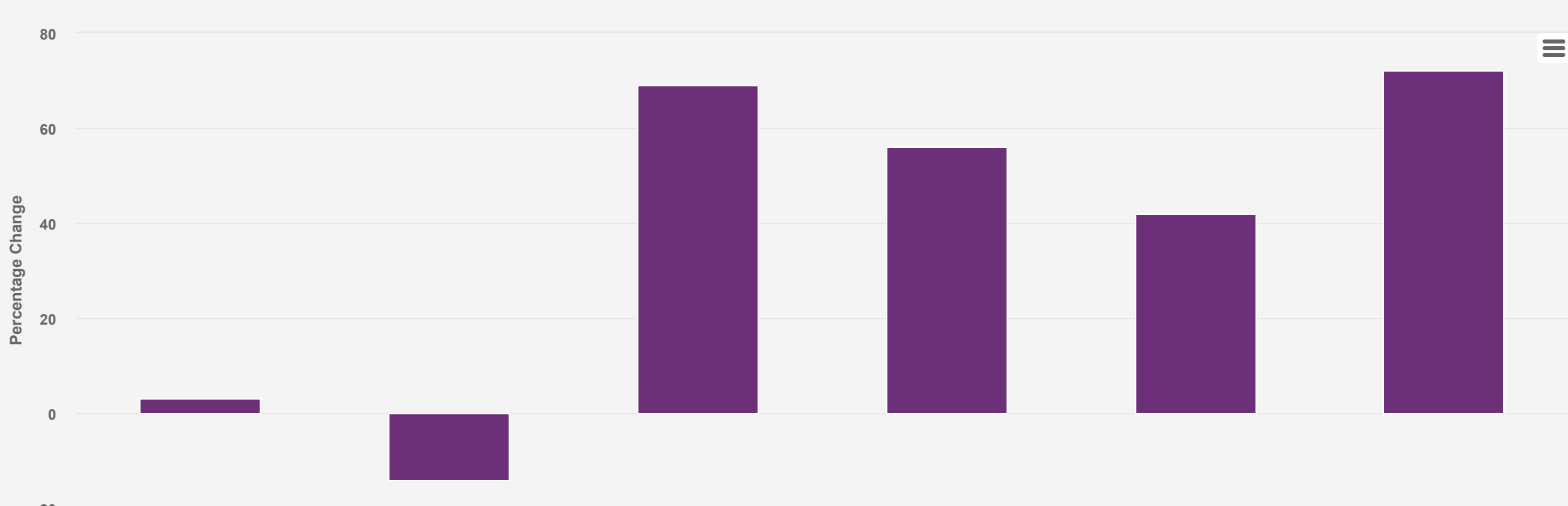

INTER-DISTRICT

Arizona districts must have open enrollment transfer provisions, with income-eligible and special needs students receiving up to 20-mile one-way transportation.

CHARTER SCHOOL

Arizona does not require public school districts to provide transportation to charter school students.

PRIVATE SCHOOL

Arizona does not require public school districts to provide transportation to private school students.
