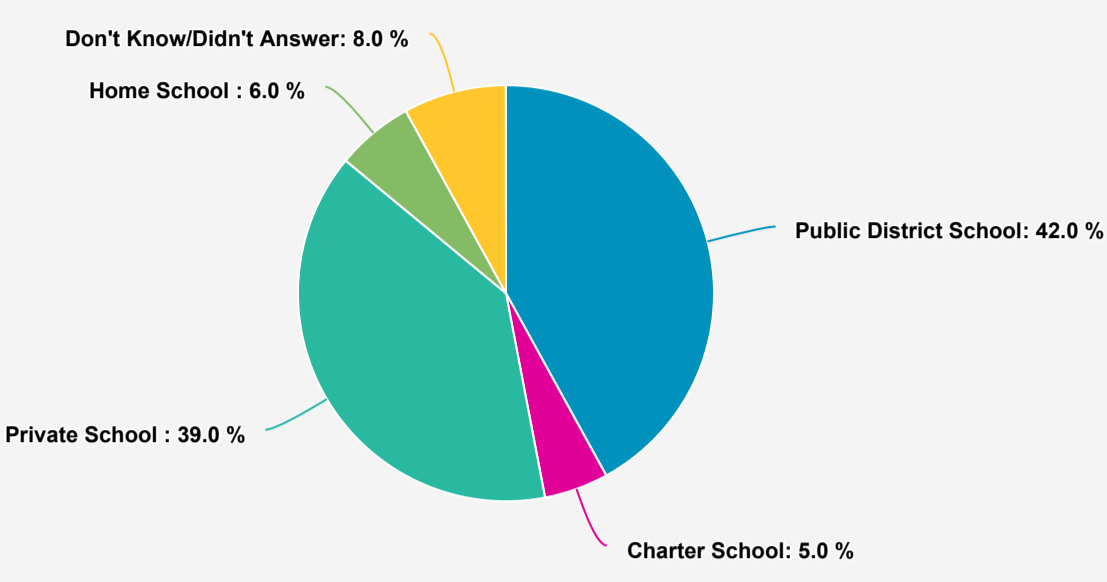

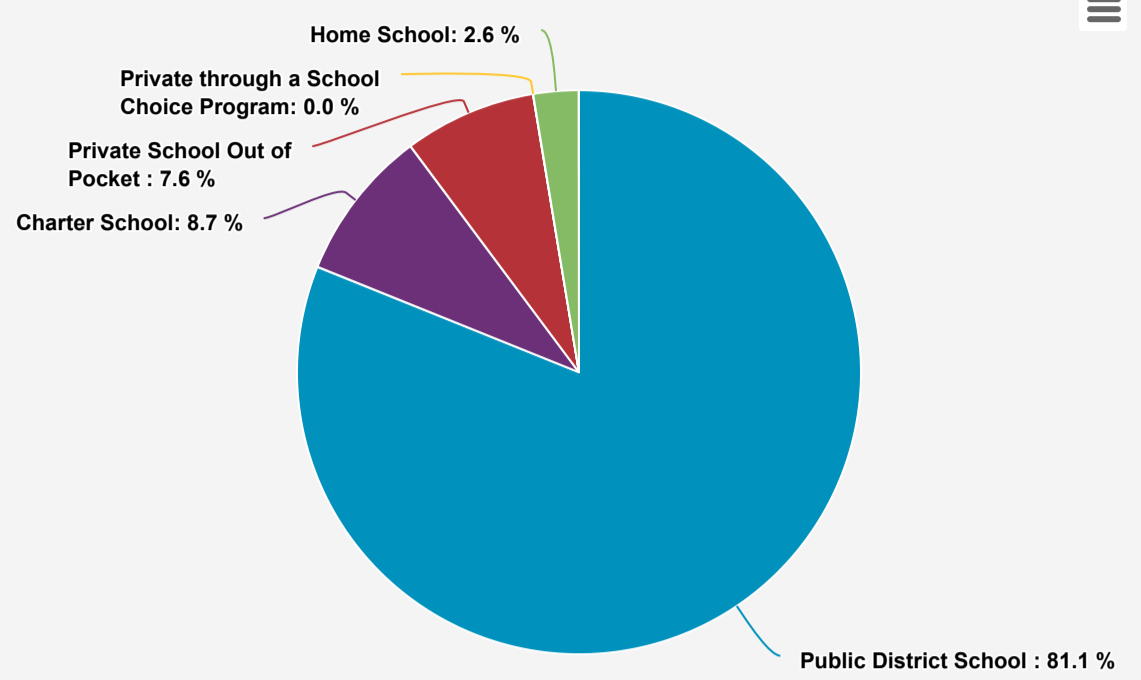

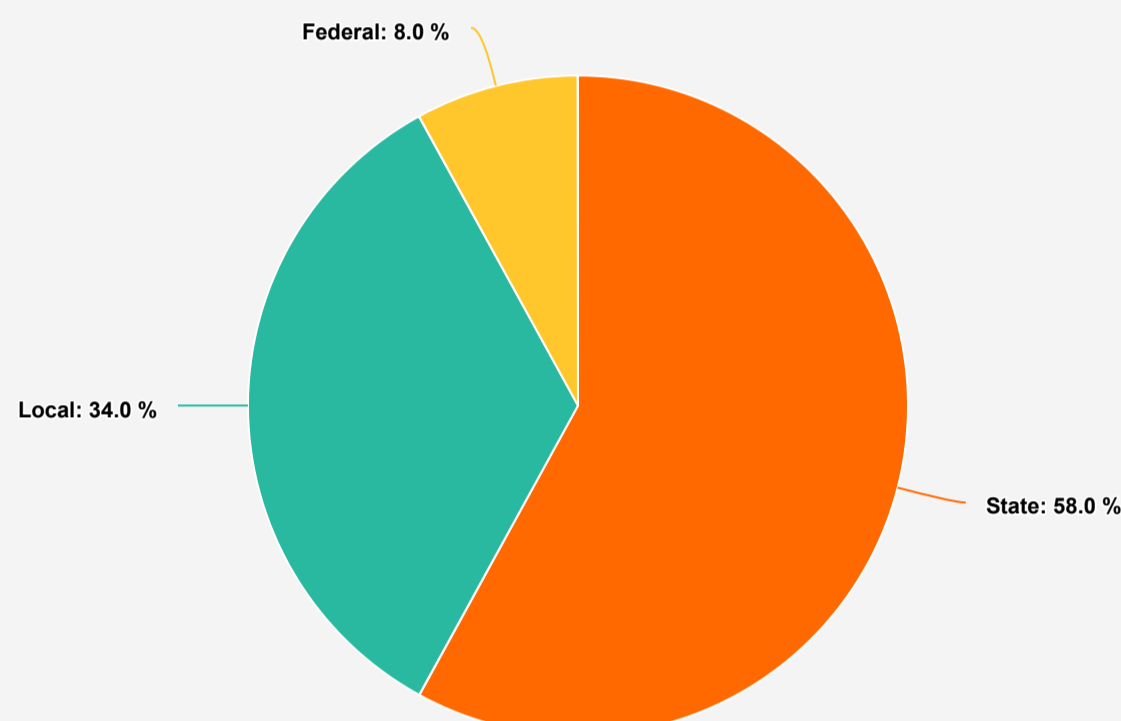

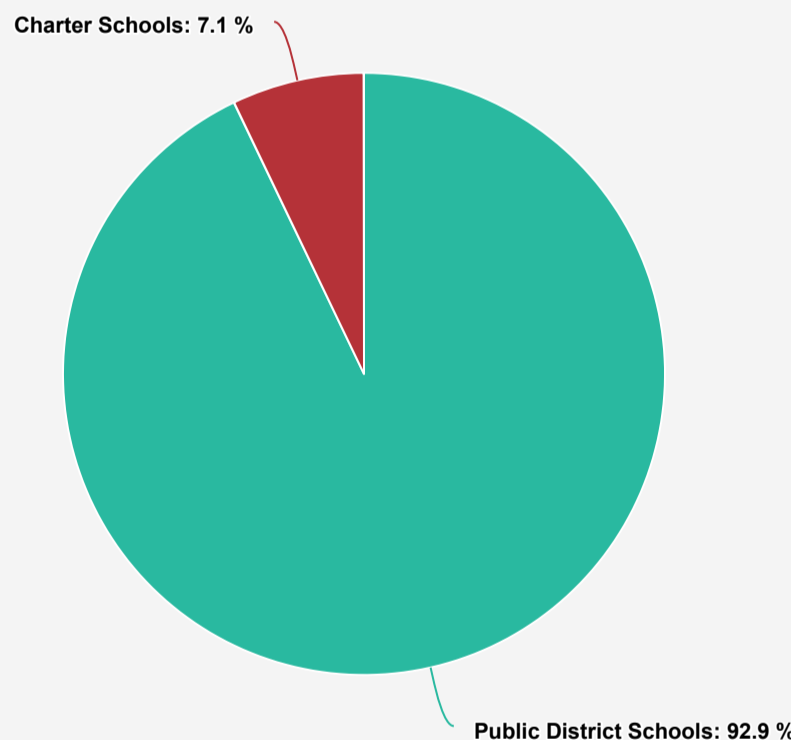

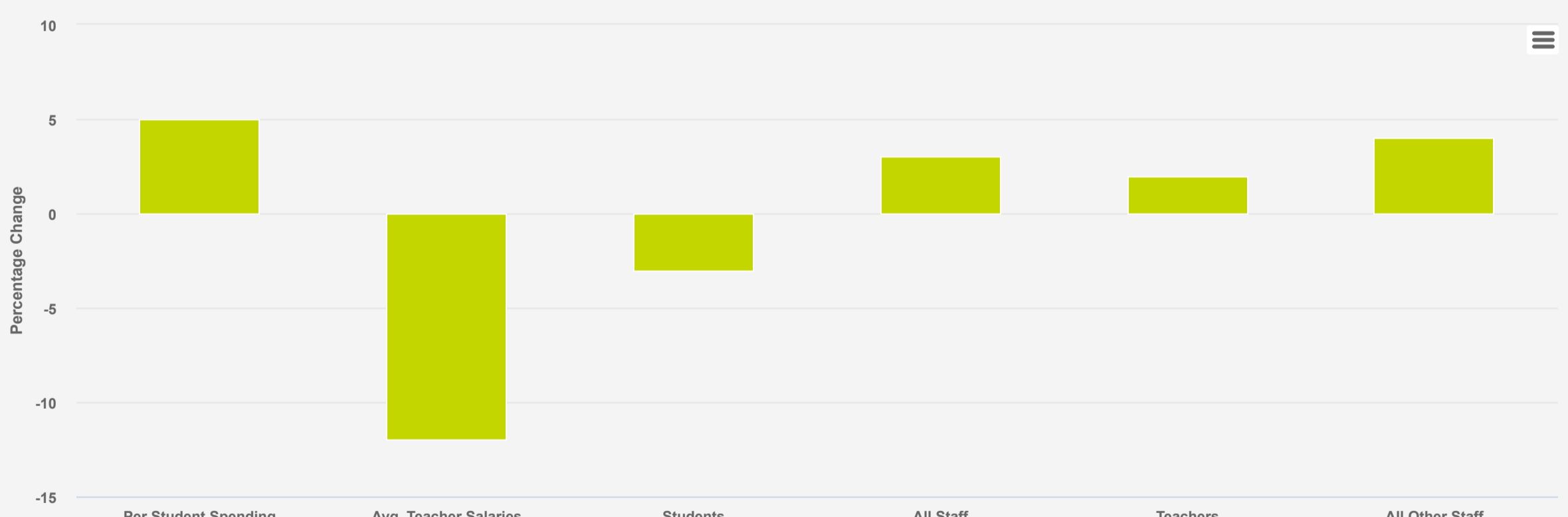
Michigan Education Spending Out of Total
