Some states allow parents to take their child out of a public district or charter school and receive a payment into a government-authorized "education savings account" - often called an "ESA" - with restricted, but multiple uses. Parents can then use these funds to pay for private school tuition and fees, online learning programs, private tutoring, community college costs, and other higher education expenses, among others.

The State of South Carolina may consider a "school choice" proposal to establish ESAs, allowing parents to send their child to the school or education provider of their choice, whether publicly or privately operated – including religious and non-religious options.
