## DRINKING A TALL WHISKEY EVBRY NIGHT DOUBLES YOUR CHANCE OF HPART DISDASE!

- Well, what is the underlying rate?
- Going from a 1 in a million chance to a 2 in a million chance is doubling the chance of something, but it is still very unlikely.
- Common with rare things, a small change in numbers can look big percentage-wise.


## COMPARED TO WHAT?

Researchers fed children broccoli every day for six months. Six months later, on average students were two inches taller. They concluded that broccoli causes children to grow.

"A third of all voucher transfers resulted in more integrated public and private schools, an additional 57 percent of transfers had mixed effects (positive effects in one sector, negative effects in another), and just 9 percent of transfers had negative effects."

## CENTURY FOUNDATION

"About a third (34 percent) of the voucher transfers had a positive effect on school integration by moving students from public schools where their race was overrepresented to private schools where their race was underrepresented. However, two-thirds of the transfers had negative or mixed effects, increasing segregation in one or both sectors. In 9 percent of transfers, students moved from a public school where their group was underrepresented to a private school where their race was overrepresented, having a negative effect on integration in both sectors."

## HOW NOT TO GDT FOOLDD BY STATISTICS

- Ask "compared to what?"
- Ask about samples: characteristics, averages, outliers
- We look at the framing and ask if it is fair
- When in doubt, give us a shout and we can look at a study for you
